TEACHING METHODOLOGY

The aim of the Subject lies on the production of knowledge through disorientation; that is, placing the student's glance where it's not comfortable by the means of a field-trip.

The demands of the workshop will consist in the analysis of several architectural projects and to react to those in terms of a new approach-proposal. The work will be in groups of minimum 2 students and will be executed during the sessions at the school to culminate in the field-trip

LEARNING OBJECTIVES OF THE SUBJECT

Objectives: TRANS, from the Latin trans ("across", "beyond"). The objective of the subject consists in the production of knowledge based on displacement, that is, placing the student's gaze on the strangeness inherent in the change of context caused by a trip. The prefix "trans" invites us to look further, recognizing that only with an unprejudiced look will we be able to build new relationships from known elements. The work will consist of the analysis of several urban phenomena of different scales and the proposal linked to them. The face-to-face process of recognizing and interpreting a reality from concrete strategies, trains students in the preparation of their own atlases of personal inspiration and both scientific and emotional content.

A project is proposed for groups of at least two students that takes place throughout the journey-workshop and culminates in a public presentation at school on the way back.
