### TEACHING METHODOLOGY

This intensive course takes students outside the comfort zone of traditional design and into those territories where space lives, changes, repairs itself and resists. No blank slate, no iconic forms: we will work on the infraordinary, on fragile ecologies and on the micro-plots that sustain urban life.

We will learn to read what normally remains invisible —silent maintenance, non-human actors, precarious networks, minimal gestures of care— and to transform this attention into radically new project tools. Fragility will become a generative force: a laboratory for thinking about architecture as alliance, diplomacy and adaptation.

The results of the course will be small repair and maintenance projects, strategies for restoring ecological plots, practices for the conscious use of resources and devices capable of responding to the climate challenge through situated and responsible interventions.
