



QUICK GUIDE

Therefore, we must be especially mindful of hygiene measures and health authority recommendations.










Always wear a face mask.








Wash your hands with soap and water or hand sanitiser.

1,5 m distance.








Stay at home and contact your doctor if:

- . You've lost your sense of taste or smell.






What should I do if I've tested positive in a PCR test?

- . Get in contact with your COVID-19 officer.
- . We will show you how to follow your courses during the quarantine.
- . We will inform the students you have been in class with.








What should I do if I've been in close contact with someone who has tested positive in a PCR test?

- . Get in contact with your **COVID-19 officer**.
- . As a precautionary measure, you will have to contact your doctor, request a PCR test and wait for the results in quarantine.
- . We will show you how to follow your courses.
- . You do not need to inform any of your fellow students.








What should I do if I've been in close contact with someone who has been in close contact with someone who has tested positive in a PCR test?
