Call for Participation

WER'08 is the eleventh edition of the Workshop on Requirements Engineering series. The workshop started as a meeting of the Ibero-American requirements engineering community, but over the years has attracted attention of researchers from other parts of the world as well. WER 2008 will be held in Barcelona, Catalonia, Spain.

Workshop Highlights

The workshop will continue with its initial objective to be a forum of discussion on the topics related with Requirements Engineering and a platform for presenting contributions and advances in Requirements Engineering to the Ibero-American community interested in the area.

The international Program Committee, from 8 different countries, is composed of 33 relevant researchers and practitioners coming both from the academia and the industry. 30 papers have been received. There were 3 reviews per paper, 16 have been accepted as full papers and 4 as short papers.

The selected papers will cover the main activities of the Requirements Engineering discipline. Their presentations will be organized into six sessions, distributed during the two days of the workshop. The topics of the sessions will include elicitation, analysis, traceability and modeling of requirements, as well as process, quality and reuse.

The program includes also an opening session with one invited speaker, Professor Roel Wieringa, who gave a talk on Business-IT Alignment in Value Webs.
