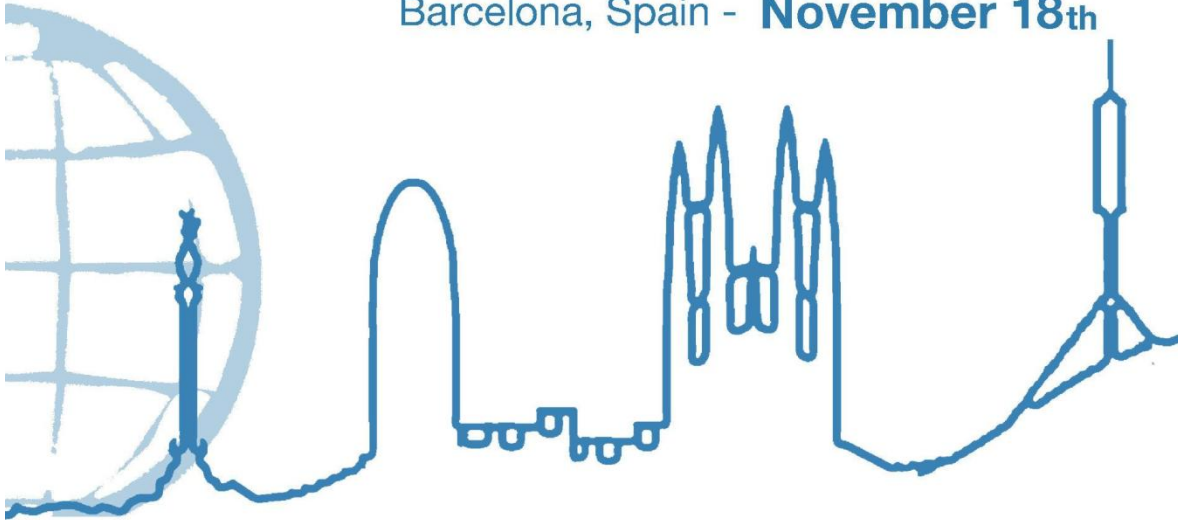

ARRIVING IN BARCELONA [\(back\)](#)

Barcelona airport is situated 18 kilometres from the city centre. These are different means of transport which connect the airport with the centre:

TRAIN - Renfe Line 2 suburban train

The airport station is situated opposite T2, and is connected to this terminal via an airbridge. There is also a Bus transit service between the Renfe station and T1. To catch the airport train (RENFE Line 10) into the city, just walk out and cross the long overhead bridge between Terminals A and B. It takes to the city centre (Main stops: 'Estació de Sants', 'Passeig de Gràcia' and 'Estació de França'). Trains run every half hour and the journey only takes 20 minutes.

Journey duration: To Barcelona Sants, 19 minutes.

Timetable: From the airport, from 06:08 to 23:38h. (every 30 minutes).

Price: Single, 2.80 euro - *Information telephone:* 902 240 202

BUS - There are some bus lines which go from the airport to the city. There is a shuttle bus service which stops outside each terminal and goes to central Plaça Catalunya every 15 minutes. The Aerobus is the most comfortable and easy way to travel between the city centre and the airport.

TAXI - *Stops:* In T1, in the arrivals zone (P0) and in the Barcelona-Madrid air corridor; in T2, opposite terminals T2A, T2B and T2C.

Price: The minimum fee is 20€. The cost payable is indicated on the meter. It is advisable to request a receipt. [You can check fees and supplements here.](#)

Taxis from the airport to Barcelona city centre take about 30 minutes depending on traffic.

ROAD - The access road to the airport, the C-31 Barcelona-Castelldefels dual carriageway, connects with the C-32 Barcelona-Sitges. From the city of Barcelona ring roads you can also access from the 'Ronda Litoral'. The airport is approximately 12 km from the city centre. The route is well sign-posted as you leave the airport.

- **From the airport:**

The best thing to do is to take a taxi. However, if you prefer the public transportation, our recommendation is:

- Take the train from the airport to Sants Estació. See: [*Renfe Line 2 suburban train*](#)
- From Sants Estació transfer to the green line of the underground, direction 'Zona Universitària'. Get off at the 'Palau Reial' metro station and follow the indications of the following map:

There are many ways to get to UPC. However, the best option is to take the green line of the underground, direction 'Zona Universitària'. You will have get off at the 'Palau Reial' station.

The weather in Barcelona

The presence of the Mediterranean air mass in Barcelona moderates temperatures. October is the beginning of autumn and the conclusion of summer.

The temperatures grow cooler and the days shorter. Days are mild and temperatures are between 13°C and 19°C.

The only inconvenience of this period of the year is that showers tend to be quite unpredictable and, consequently, it is very convenient to take an umbrella with you.
