





### **Money**

In Barcelona, you can generally pay by credit card in most places. However, it's always a good idea to have some cash on hand, especially for smaller shops, markets, or tipping.

If you need to exchange money for euros, you can find exchange offices at the airport or official banks, particularly in tourist areas. Keep in mind that exchange rates at airport exchange offices may not be the most competitive; banks or ATMs often offer better rates.

Another convenient option is to withdraw money directly from ATMs, which are widely available. Be sure to check with your bank about any international transaction fees or daily withdrawal limits before you travel. Withdrawing a mix of denominations can also be helpful for smaller purchases.

# The weather in Barcelona and tips to prepare your luggage

Barcelona in early June typically enjoys warm and sunny weather. You can expect average daytime temperatures ranging from 20°C to 25°C, with evenings being pleasantly mild, dropping to around 18°C. Rainfall is generally low during this period, with mostly sunny days perfect for exploring the city.

For packing your luggage, focus on light and breathable summer clothing. Include a light jacket for the cooler evenings or if you plan to visit air-conditioned spaces. Comfortable walking shoes are essential as you'll likely be doing a lot of sightseeing. Don't forget a hat, sunglasses, and high SPF sunscreen to protect yourself from the strong sun

While rain is not very common, a small, foldable umbrella or a light rain jacket could be useful for unexpected brief showers.

In general, the weather is quite pleasant, but it's always good to check the forecast closer to your visit to be prepared for any changes.
