ABOUT THE EVENT

Seminars will be held in Lyon, Paris Monday and Tuesday and in Bordeaux and Lyon on Thursday and Friday. The group in Paris will be split to go to Bordeaux and Lyon. Professors can choose the group they want to be in. Wednesday 6 February will be dedicated to transportation from Paris to Bordeaux/Lyon and to a cultural activity.

Participating professors will be responsible for the following:

- Creating one seminar in English with 6 contact hours. The seminar will be taught on Each day, each campus to different groups. The same course will be taught 6 times = 36 teaching hours.
- Evaluating students for each seminar (individual exam, group work, case-study, re-search paper...etc.) during the 6h of class, or afterwards (homework).
